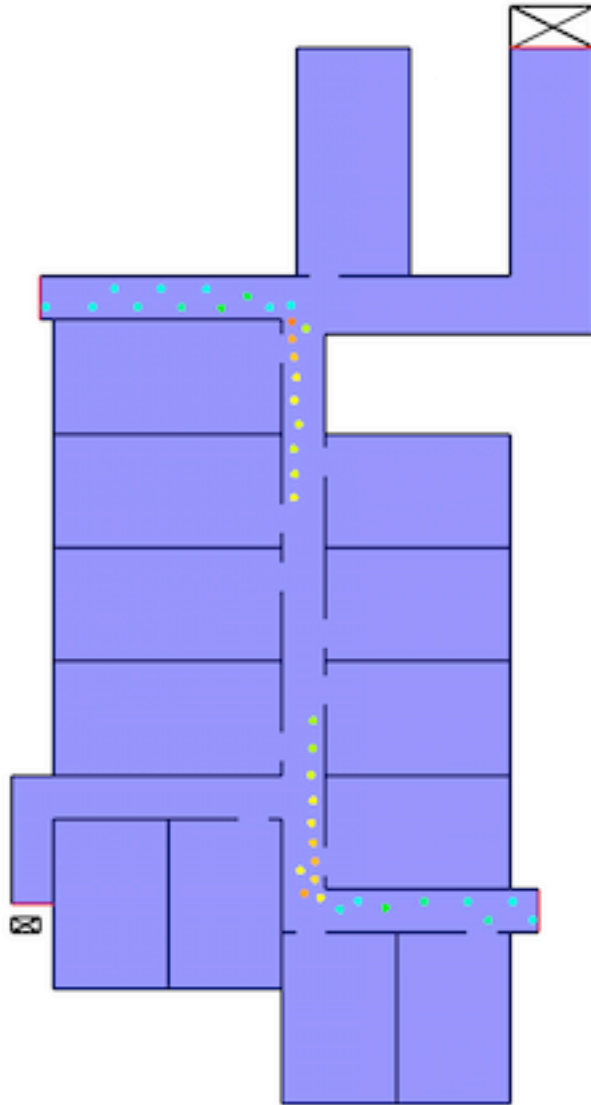


Figure 1: Simulation using jpscore
